Greetings from OMSC! This issue of the *Hearth* offers you a little glimpse of life here at 490 Prospect Street. We hope you are encouraged by what you see!

Twice each year, I ask you to help support the missionaries and church leaders from all over the world who come to OMSC for physical, professional, and spiritual renewal. Our most palpable recurring need is for the support of our international scholarships, a portion of which entails the medical expenses alluded to in my column in *The Hearth*. A furnished apartment, a small monthly allowance, and free access to seminars, lectures, and mission forums are among the benefits received by those who are granted scholarships.

This year's eleven scholarship recipients are outstanding Christian leaders— Baptist, Anglican, Pentecostal, Methodist, Presbyterian, and independent— from Myanmar (from five different ethnic groups), India, Ghana, Sri Lanka, Cuba, Korea, and Malaysia. The cost to OMSC is approximately \$132,000 spread over ten months.
