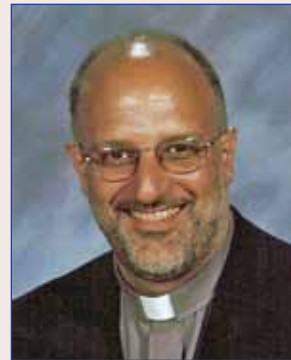

He is also Director of the Missions Institute of Orthodox Christianity at Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology, Brookline, Massachusetts; and an Overseas Ministries Study Center Board of Trustees member. He became interested in Orthodox missions as a Holy Cross student and soon thereafter was a missionary in Africa. In 1994 he relocated to Albania. Veronis is author of *Go Forth! Stories of Missions and Resurrection in Albania* (2010).
